## **Art Course**

Age: 7 – 12 years old

Number of classes: 2 classes a week, each class consists of 2 parts each of 60 minutes (24x2 h, double classes)

Duration of the program: 3 months

Necessary accessories: sheets of watercolor paper A3; primed canvas or cardboard; firm-soft pencil, sharpener, eraser; synthetic brushes thin, medium and thick; a set of watercolor paints, a set of gouache paints, a can of gouache whitewash, a set of acrylic paints, acrylic whitewash; a plank or a thick cardboard of a slightly larger A3 size; water jar, a cloth for soaking the brush; when studying outdoors a mat for sitting, a cap, a cape and drinking water.

The number of themes may be reduced or increased (more or less hours for a theme) depending on the speed of work and the efficiency of the material assimilation. The themes of classes may be changed in case of pedagogical necessity.
